Ray Reynolds thanked the council for his position. He is at his one year anniversary and has a super boss and administrator and appreciates everything they do.

Ric Martinez reported new officers Bowman and Rosen are doing well. All three of the new officers will be attending the lowa Law Enforcement Academy in two weeks. The Community Service Officer will start May 4<sup>th</sup>.
