1. Call to Order

Mayor Lynn Lathrop, convened the meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, April 25, 2016, pursuant to the rules of the Council. Hansen also inquired about continuing discussion regarding Gates Hall. Consensus was to continue the discussion.

Brett Barker updated the Council on the US Highway 30 Task Force meeting. The Mayor, City Administrator and Engineer will meet with the DOT and railroad to discuss costs and construction phasing before the next meeting will be scheduled for the task force.

Elizabeth Hansen advised Council there will be a Bike Rodeo, Bike Sale and Pet Licensing Event at the City Hall Campus on May 21st.

Shawn Cole reported that Manatt's have begun work in town. The railroad is also working on some of their crossings.

Tim Hansen thanked council for their support. Gates Hall will be hosting prom this weekend and staff will be preparing the cemetery for Memorial Day. Hansen noted that last Friday the high school students and teachers held a day of community service at various locations throughout Nevada. The city hosted students and staff at City Hall, Gates Hall, Pool, Cemetery, SCORE, Fire Department and the Library. The city staff would like to thank those participating.

Ray Reynolds relayed he had seven students painting fire hydrants. He is working on an RFP for Air Packs that are due for replacement. Reynolds thanked Shawn Cole for his work in pursuing the demolition of a house that was damaged by fire.

Ric Martinez noted Holly Bowman has passed her EMT National Test. Community Service Officer Kali Warner is testing today. All the officers will soon be EMT Certified.

Kerin Wright updated the Council on the water meter project. Wright reported on her attendance at the Iowa Employment Conference.

Larry Stevens advised staff has been working on smaller projects. The survey and design for 6th and 8th Streets. They have also been working on the number one goal from the Council retreat, the intersection of Lincoln Highway and Airport Road. He has been in contact with the DOT and there is a possibility of a 50% grant that could be obtained to help with the costs of the intersection.
