Beth Williams reported there were 241 Audio Books and 268 Ebooks checked out in 2016. This is an increase from the previous year.

Tim Hansen informed council the Boys/Girls Club is not losing their space at the high school yet. He felt they should take a step back and research the issue before moving forward. Staff is preparing for spring programs and activities.

Shawn Cole advised he is attending training on Thursday and Friday. Wednesday he will be interviewing for an intern.

Mike Neal noted the street department is again at full staff. He attended the Story County Conservation meeting last month. Neal was asked about the street plows. He advised they are working well.

Ric Martinez advised the fire station remodel is progressing. Volunteers are assisting with the renovation. Martinez noted they had been asked to attend the Story County Board of Supervisors meeting and update the supervisors on stover issue. Brian Hanson asked Martinez to relay his appreciation to the staff when they responded to his personal incident.

Kerin Wright reported she is working on the Budget paperwork. Wright is also working with the state auditor's office to finalize the FY2016 Audit Report. It is hoped to have it available by the end of February.

Larry Stevens informed council the plans for 2017 Streets Project are complete. Bids will be open in early February. March will be the bid date for the Asphalt Project. Staff will also be reviewing the Lift station by Gates Hall.
