Andy Kelly inquired about the down payment assistance grant the city had received. Kerin Wright advised those grant funds have ended.

Beth Williams noted it is National Library Week and they will be having Musical Lunch Breaks April 11-13th. They are also collecting donations for Nevada Community Cupboard the entire month of April.

Mike Neal reported staff has attended pesticide training. They have also been sweeping streets, jetting sewers and patching. Neal and Shawn Ludwig attended a Water/Wastewater Conference to obtain CEU's for their certificates.

Shawn Cole updated the council on the 2017 CIP Street Improvement Project. The sewer was in last week and the water should be completed this week. Testing on the water will be performed before switched over. Storm sewers will be next. The 2017 Sidewalk Program is getting underway.

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Kerin Wright reported she attended the Iowa Employment Conference last week in Altoona. There will be more detail in the next report.

Larry Stevens noted the contractors for the 2017 CIP Street Project are making good progress. The 2017 Asphalt project bid letting will be held on April 19th with the bids presented to council on April 24th.
