Mayor Barker reminded all the burning proclamation is set to expire on Friday, August 28<sup>th</sup>. He also thanked staff, State DOT and community members for all their help and working together during the storm.

Council Member Nealson thanked Marlys Barker and Mayor Barker for organizing a team of volunteers to assist some residents over the weekend. He also reminded all the Lincoln Highway Dash is slated for Saturday, August 29<sup>th</sup>. Saturday morning and Candidate coffees were discussed.

Director of Fire/EMS Reynolds reviewed the Storm debriefing with the council. The first firefighter has been diagnosed with COVID-19. Return to work after infection is not consistent with different agencies. The 911 Verbio Climb will be implementing temperature monitoring and staged climbs, along with other safety features.

Public Works Director Rydl thanked all who helped in the clean-up. Everyone worked well together. He expressed his appreciation to the lowa DOT for their help in the debris clean up.

City Clerk Wright updated the council on the Local Option Sales Tax and Road Use Tax outlook. The State Audit will begin within the next couple weeks. Participated in the FEMA and State Reimbursement Webinars. An additional Street Finance Report webinar is tomorrow to review the new state forms for the report. Marlys Barker prepared an RFP for a new City sign.

Mayor Barker thanked Shawn Cole and Marlys Barker for doing the Friday downtown updates.
