1. CALL TO ORDER

The City Council of the City of Nevada, Iowa, met for a meeting in the Council Chambers of Nevada City Hall located at 1209 6th Street, Nevada, Iowa. Mayor Brett Barker, convened the meeting at 6:02 p.m. on Monday, September 26, 2022, pursuant to the rules of the Council. The agenda was posted on the official bulletin board in compliance with the open meeting law.
