The position reports to the Board of Trustees and works with a dedicated staff. They direct all administrative, professional, and technical library activities.

Primary Job Responsibilities Include:

- Develop effective and positive working relationships with community leaders, city leaders, Board of Trustees, and Library staff, as well as Library patrons.
- Management of Library personnel.
