Parks and recreation reserve the right to combine classes that do not fill. Fee is \$40.00/session. DO NOT register your child for more than one session.

Safe Shark Swim Time



Safe Shark Swims are a time when parents and infants/toddlers are invited to the aquatic center to become more comfortable, learn water safety, and develop foundational swimming skills. These sessions will be offered free of charge, however, there must be at least a 1:1 parent/child ratio. Dates are: June 6, 13, 20 and 27 from 5:00 – 6:00 p.m. Some instruction and free play will be offered during all sessions.

Discount passes are available at \$5.00 off April 1 – April 21.

Season Pass Options:

Individual Season Pass: \$60.00 +tax

Pass is good for one season for an individual. Pass is not good for special events outside regular pool hours.

Senior Season Pass: \$50.00 +tax

Pass is good for one season for individuals 55 years of age and older. Pass is not good for special events outside regular pool hours.

Toddler Season Pass: \$50.00 +tax

Pass is good for one season for an individual 2-3 Years Old. Pass is not good for special events outside regular pool hours.

General Admission: \$6.00

All patrons ages 4-54 must pay to enter the pool facility regardless of their intent to swim or not. General admission includes use of all pool facilities.

Senior Admission: \$5.00

All individuals over the age of 55 may receive a complimentary \$1.00 discount off the regular general admission price. Discounted rate must be requested.

Toddler Rate (2-3 years): \$5.00

Children 1 and under: FREE

All children 1 and under receive free admission when accompanied by a paying adult.

Punch Pass: \$60.00

10 admissions to the Aquatic Center. Punch cards are available to purchase at the Aquatic Center only.

Aquatic Center Important Info.

- 7 year-oldsand under must be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years or older.
- Lifejackets are the only form of flotation device allowed.
- No Coolers.
- Everyone must pay the admission fee whether swimming or not.
- Wear appropriate swim attire. No tshirts, cutoffs, jean shorts, or any swimwear with a metal buckle.
 Appropriate attire is ultimately determined by facility staff.
- Food items must remain in the concession area.
- Snorkel masks are NOT allowed.
- No hard balls. All toys at the discretion of facility staff.
